## Learning Outcomes

### Fachliche Qualifikationsziele und Berufsbefähigung

Der Master-Studiengang befähigt zur Sammlungs- und Provenienzforschung in Museen, Sammlungen und sonstigen Wissensspeichern von der Antike bis zur Gegenwart. Im Rahmen ihrer Ausbildung erlangen die Studierenden ein fundiertes Wissen über Konzepte und Aufgaben der Sammlungs- und Provenienzforschung sowie über den Erhalt des Kulturellen Erbes; sie erwerben analytisch-methodisches Wissen ebenso wie anwendungsbezogene Fertigkeiten. Die forschungsbasierte Vertiefung in den Fächern Kunstgeschichte, Museologie und Geschichte vermittelt weitere Kompetenzen, die für eine Karriere in sammelnsbezogenen Institutionen (Kunsthandel, Museen und andere Wissensspeicher) notwendig sind. Damit qualifiziert der Master-Studiengang „Sammlungen - Provenienz - Kulturelles Erbe“ für eine wissenschaftlich ausgerichtete Laufbahn in der Sammlungspflege und -forschung in Museen und Sammlungen, im Kunsthandel sowie in wissenschaftlichen Institutionen: speziell in der Provenienzforschung im Hinblick auf NS-verfolgungsbedingt entzogenes Kulturgut (NS-Raubgut), auf Kulturgutentziehungen in SBZ und DDR sowie auf Kultur- und Sammlungsgut aus kolonialen Kontexten. Der Erwerb von Vermittlungs- und Präsentationskompetenzen befähigt darüber hinaus zur Arbeit im Museums- und Ausstellungssektor, in der Erwachsenenbildung oder in den Medien.

### Persönlichkeitsentwicklung und gesellschaftliches Engagement

Zur Persönlichkeitsentwicklung der Studierenden trägt die Diskussionskultur in den Seminaren bei. Hier wird die Bereitschaft zum wissenschaftlichen Diskurs gefördert und die Befähigung erreicht, eine Diskussion auf Fachebene zu führen. Der Umgang mit Kritik und Kritikfähigkeit ist ebenfalls Bestandteil der Arbeit in den Seminaren. Die Behandlung einzelner Themen in selbstständig arbeitenden Gruppen fördern die Teamfähigkeit und gleichzeitig Selbstverantwortung.

Außerhalb der Lehre können sich die Studierenden in der Fachschaft einbringen, die eigenständige Exkursionen zu Kunstaustellungen oder in Kunstzentren organisiert. Auch die von den Studierenden betriebene Museumsinitiative im Martin von Wagner Museum gehört zu den extracurricularen Aktivitäten am Institut für Kunstgeschichte. Die Mitglieder dieses eingetragenen Vereins helfen bei Veranstaltungen des Museums oder des Lehrstuhls in vielfältiger Weise. Sie beaufsichtigen auch die im Modul „Museologie für Kunsthistoriker“ von jedem Hauptfachabsolventen geforderte kunsthistorische Führung, die jeweils Sonntags für gemischtes Publikum angeboten wird. Eigenverantwortlich veranstaltet die Museumsinitiative ebenfalls Führungen durch das universitätseigene Museum und arbeitet mit bei größeren Events in Würzburg, etwa mit einem Kinderprogramm bei dem Festival „Umsonst und Draußen“. Diese Form des gesellschaftlichen Engagements ist fester Bestandteil der Arbeit der Museumsinitiative. Die Wahlmöglichkeiten, die insbesondere im Bereich des Master-Studiengangs angeboten werden, helfen den Studierenden eigene Interessensgebiete besonders zu vertiefen. Hierzu dient gerade auch das Modul Kulturwissenschaften, in dem über das Fach hinausgehende Neigungen verfolgt werden können, aber auch interdisziplinäre Ansätze einer späteren Forschungsleistung gefördert werden.

Interkulturelle Kompetenz erwerben die Studierenden im Umgang mit Kommilitoninnen und Kommilitonen aus anderen Nationen. Auf das Angebot des „Wurzburg English Learning Programm“ WELP wird in den jeweiligen Einführungsveranstaltungen ebenso nachdrücklich verwiesen, wie auf die Veranstaltungsangebote des GSIC-Projekts (Globale Systeme und interkulturelle Kompetenz) der Uni Würzburg.
