### Wissenschaftliche Befähigung

- Die Studierenden haben einen Einblick die grundlegenden Probleme, Positionen, Diskurse und historischen Strömungen in der Philosophie.

• Die Absolvent/innen können im beruflichen Kontext den Transfer der von ihnen erworbenen wissenschaftlichen Methoden der Philosophie (wissenschaftliche Arbeitstechniken, Bearbeitung von wissenschaftlichen Fragestellungen, Abfassung verschiedener philosophischer Texttypen, Literaturrecherche, Text- und Argumentationsanalyse, Kritikfähigkeit etc.) auf ihnen unbekannte Praxisfelder und Probleme in fremden Fachgebieten leisten. Sie sind z.B. dazu in der Lage, komplexe Themen und Texte zu erfassen, diese nach ethischen und logischen Gesichtspunkten kritisch zu bewerten und Ihren Standpunkt klar zu formulieren.
