Course of Studies - Contents and Objectives

The program conveys fundamental scientifically sound knowledge in Art Education as well as significant skills in the sphere of activity of Art Education. Degree holders gain a scientific training in the fields of science of art, aesthetic education as well as skills of art and aesthetic practice. They acquire basic competences in the creation of art. Furthermore, the graduates gain an insight in the relevance of materials in aesthetic education and were able to test themselves in situations similar to those of future occupational areas. Among the competences acquired is the recognition of correlations in the fields of knowledge and the sphere of activity in Art Education as well as their didactic implementation.

The Graduates are qualified to organize and put into practice such situations of procurance of knowledge and to accompany processes of aesthetic education.
