#### Wissenschaftliche Befähigung

- Solide Lese-, Übersetzungs- und Sprachkompetenzen in der modernen indischen Sprache Hindi oder, je nach Spezialisierung, in der klassischen indischen Sprache Sanskrit, einschließlich der Schriftsysteme. Absolvent/innen sind in der Lage, komplexe Texte zu konkreten und abstrakten Themen zu verstehen und zu analysieren. Zudem erlangen sie grundlegende Kenntnisse in der zweiten indischen Sprache (Hindi oder Sanskrit) sowie ein fundiertes Überblickswissen zu den Systemebenen der indischen Sprachen (Phonologie, Morphologie, Syntax, Semantik) und den Literaturen Indiens.
