



#### Programme requirements:

Fundamental principles of the Study of Religions. General knowledge of the fundamental ideas as well as the historic development of different religions. General knowledge of systematic and theoretical concepts of the Study of Religions. Introduction to the philosophical foundations of Cultural Studies. General knowledge of philosophical concepts, relevant for the Study of Religions.

General knowledge of methods and theory of the historic and systematic study of religions. Ability to do an in depth analysis of religious ideas as well as their historic, cultural and social context. General knowledge of philosophical approaches concerning the Study of Religions.
