Course of Studies - Contents and Objectives

The certificate program Detecting and preventing abuse of power (MEV) is offered by the Faculty of Human Sciences together with the Faculty of Catholic Theology and Faculty of Medicine of JMU as further education study program according to article 78 paragraph 2, sentence 2, no. 2, letter b) BayHIG and is aimed at professionals who wish to further their qualifications in accordance with Art. 78 BayHIG, who are active in hierarchical structures, who care for others and who can act as multipliers.

The aim of the certificate program is to impart skills to students and employees, as well as to those working in relevant contexts, which will enable them to recognize, competently assess, and appropriately respond to abusive behavior and psychological, physical, and sexual violence in their current or future fields of practice and career.

Based on the study programme, the faculties named in the first sentence will issue a certificate for the certificate programme Detecting and preventing abuse of power (MEV) after all required module achievements have been completed in accordance with this FSB.
