### Psychology (13 ECTS credits)

In the case of a combined degree or extension with psychology with a focus on school psychology, the study components from psychology – and thus the subject-specific admission requirements for the first state examination in accordance with Section 32 (1) No. 1 letter b) double letter cc) LPO I – are not directly completed as part of the educational science program, but rather as part of the psychology program with a focus on school psychology in accordance with § 110 LPO I (§ 32 (4) sentence 2 LPO I). The modules in which the subject-specific admission requirements pursuant to Section 32 (1) No. 1) letter b) double letter cc) LPO I are acquired are listed accordingly in the applicable FSB for the subject of psychology with a focus on school psychology.

### Internship in school (4 ECTS credits)

Students studying for a teaching degree Grundschule, Mittelschule, Realschule, or Gymnasium must complete a practical training in didactics and teaching methodology (studienbegleitendes fachdidaktisches Praktikum) pursuant to Section 34 Subsection 1 No. 4 LPO I (examination regulations for teaching-degree programmes) and must attend the accompanying tutorial. Students studying for a teaching degree Grundschule or Mittelschule must complete the respective courses in the subject they selected as Unterrichtsfach (subject studied with a focus on the scientific discipline), students studying for a teaching degree Realschule or Gymnasium must complete the respective courses in one of the subjects they selected as Unterrichtsfach or vertieft studiertes Fach (subject studied with a focus on the scientific discipline). Details on the practical training in didactics and teaching methodology as well as the accompanying tutorial are set out in the FSB (subject-specific provisions) and SFB (list of modules) of the respective subjects.

If the course of study for teaching at elementary schools, middle schools, or secondary schools is expanded to include a major in psychology with a focus on school psychology, the major in psychology with a focus on school psychology replaces the study of a teaching subject (Art. 14 No. 4, 15 No. 4, 16 No. 3 BayLBG). As part of the teacher training program for secondary schools, the subject-specific teaching internship must be completed in the remaining teaching subject. The following rule applies to the teacher training program for elementary schools and middle schools: Due to the elimination of the (single) teaching subject, the subject-specific teaching internship must be completed in one of the teaching subjects chosen as part of elementary school teaching or the teaching subjects of a subject group at the middle school. The modules of the subject-specific teaching internship and the accompanying course are regulated in the subject-specific provisions of the respective teaching subject, unless

the subject in question is offered exclusively as a teaching subject. In the latter case, the module of the subject-specific teaching internship is regulated in the subject-specific provisions of the respective teaching subject, provided that the subject-specific teaching internship is offered in the subject in question.

When extending studies for teaching at primary schools and when extending studies for teaching at secondary schools by studying psychology with a focus on school psychology (Art. 14 No. 4 and Art. 15 No. 4 BayLBG), the following applies in deviation from § 22 (2) No. 1 letter h) LPO I, 10 credit points must be earned in additional teacher training courses at the university in the areas specified in Sections 22 (2) No. 1 (a) to (g) LPO I (Section 22 (4) sentence 1 No. 2 LPO I).
