Among applicants with the same number of successfully completed modules, places will be allocated according to the total number of ECTS credits achieved in the corresponding modules. b. When places are allocated in accordance with b) and the number of applications exceeds the number of available places, places will be allocated according to the average grade of assessments taken in the corresponding courses. c. Among applicants with the same average grade, places will be allocated by lot. (2) Any remaining places are available to students who have not yet successfully completed any courses of the supervising chair. The selection is made according to study progress (number of semesters); among applicants with the same number of semesters, places will be allocated by lot. A waiting list will be maintained and places re-allocated as they become available.
